

Jack Sen Benevolent Association Scholarship Award Application Form – 2023

The Jack Sen Benevolent Association Scholarship Committee is now accepting applications for the 2023 Jack Sen Benevolent Association Scholarship Awards. 18 scholarships will be available in the English division, with two awards per grade level from 8th grade through senior year of college. In addition, 24 scholarships will be available in the Chinese division, with two awards per grade level from 1st grade through 12th grade. All applicants will be screened and judged by the Scholarship Committee. For eligibility requirements, please refer to the second page. Scholarship recipients will be invited to an award ceremony held at Far East Restaurant in San Francisco on the evening of August 19th, 2023. Awards are distributed as follows:

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Applicant must be a Jack Sen Benevolent Association's member in good standing. **Student's membership number (not your parent's number) must be entered on the application for consideration.**
2. Applicant must be a legal resident of California and have attended a public school or university in California from 8th grade through college senior year.
3. Applicant must be a full time student for school year 2022-2023 and have met the following academic standards:
 - a) Eighth Grade Students – must achieve grade point average of 3.8 or higher.
 - b) High School Students – must complete a minimum of 12 courses, with an overall grade point average of 3.8 or higher. (Note: H and AP classes shall be based on a 5.0 scale – A=5, B=4, C=3...)
 - c) College Students - must complete a minimum of 24 units for the last 2 semesters or 36 units for the last three quarters with an overall grade point average of 3.3 or higher.
 - d) **In case of a tie, the applicant is encouraged to forward verifiable extra curricular activity(ies), achievements and/or award certificates to the Scholarship Committee for consideration.**
4. Photocopies of report cards or official transcripts for the **whole academic year** must be submitted together with application, along with proof of student vaccination status.
5. High school or college seniors **must** continue their study at a higher-class level during fall '23. **Proof of acceptance or registration** to a college, graduate program or equivalent must be accompanied along with the application. **(Do not send originals unless requested, documents will not be returned).**
6. Application form is available on the Association's web site (<http://www.jacksentong.org>). All applications must be received by **July 21, 2023**.
7. **Late, incomplete or falsified applications will be disqualified. All decisions made by the Scholarship Committee are final. No exceptions.**
8. Award winners will be posted on the website (<http://www.jacksentong.org>) by **August 7th, 2023**.
